

## *VOLUNTEER SHOPPER*

### Goal:

As a Volunteer Shopper you will facilitate your care receiver's ability to access nutritious food and other essential items by assisting with grocery shopping and errand running. This involves either assisting your care receiver at the store or shopping for them.

### Qualifications (in addition to those of the Volunteer Caregiver):

- Valid Pennsylvania Driving License, vehicle registration, and vehicle insurance
- Clean driving record
- Safe vehicle, up to date on inspections

### Responsibilities (in addition to those of the Volunteer Caregiver):

- Keep accurate records of money exchanged for purchasing groceries/other items
- The Volunteer Shopper must be able to lift and carry groceries

### *EITHER:*

- Provide transportation for a care receiver to and from the store, assist with shopping while in the store, and assist with unpacking groceries at the care receiver's home.
  - Includes transporting care receiver in personal vehicle
  - Includes assisting care receiver into and out of vehicle and providing a steady arm if needed to assist care receiver from house to vehicle, vehicle to appointment location, and back again

### *OR:*

- Collect a shopping list from a care receiver, conduct grocery shopping for the individual, deliver the items to the care receiver's home, and provide assistance unpacking the groceries

### Reporting:

- Report volunteer hours on a monthly basis, including travel time plus the time you spend at the store and putting groceries away
